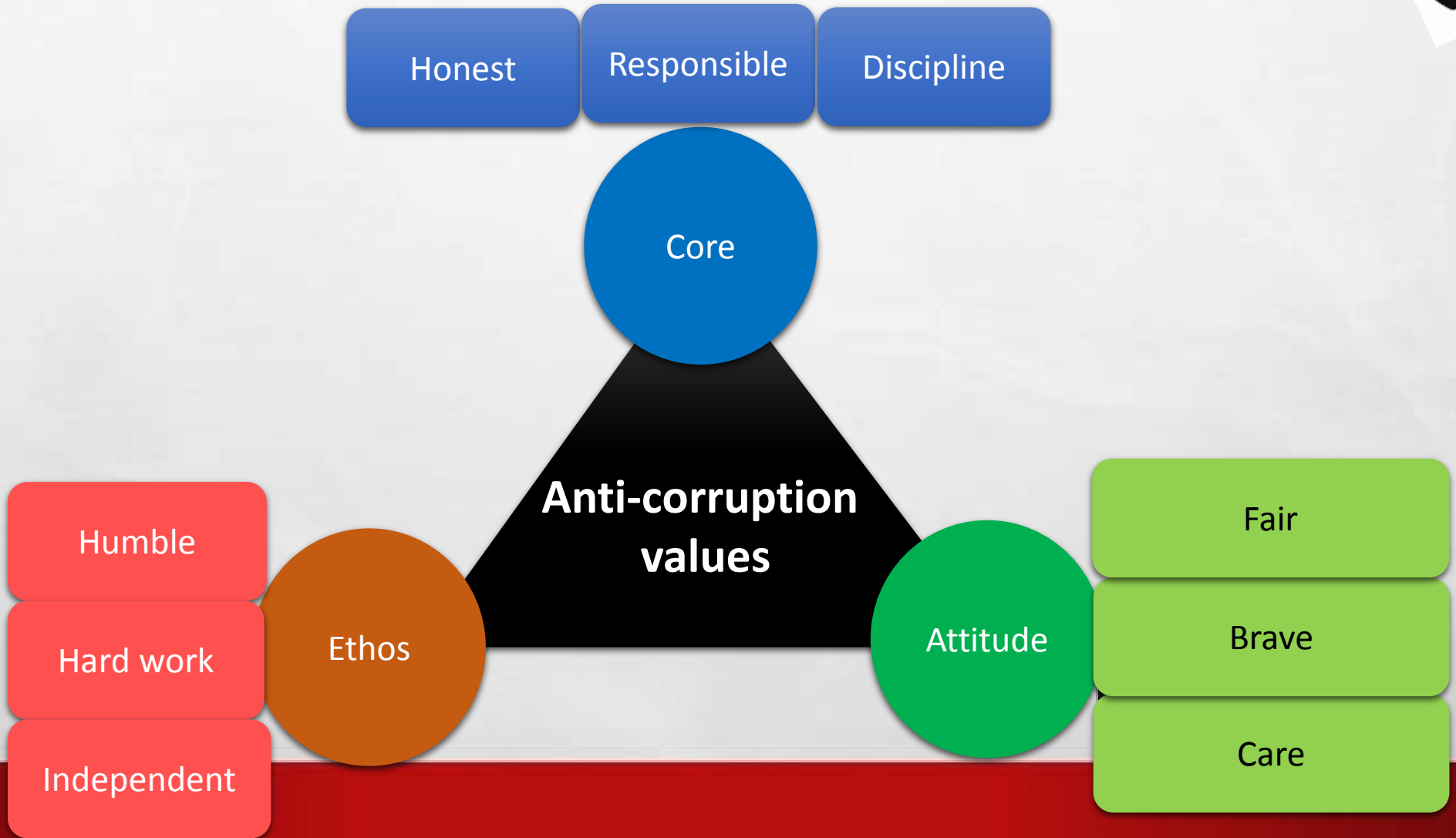

Statistics of Education



Formal education in Indonesia is attended by around 63 Million students, consist of Basic Education of 42 Million Students (grade 1-9), Senior Secondary (grade 10-12 and vocational education) of 9 Million and Higher Education of 6 Million students (university, college, polytechnic etc).

Education process involved almost 4 Million teachers/lecturers which 60% of those serve for Basic Education at both public and private schools. Formal education in Indonesia run in 349,000 Schools/universities. Almost half of those is primary schools and 3,800 universities.
